

Global perspectives on adaptive wildlife management PhD course, 7.5 ECTS



An interdisciplinary course, comparing adaptive wildlife management in northern and southern hemisphere systems, starting December 2020 and including a 16-day field trip in the Kruger National Park, South Africa (2–17 January 2021)

Application deadline: September 15, 2020



No course fee but students have to cover travel to/from Johannesburg and contribute to accommodation costs. Students must be admitted to a doctoral program, ideally in a subject relevant to wildlife management or nature conservation.
